2023: The Year of Living Fruitfully: Sowing | Serving | Reaping John 15: 1-8, 16

Habakkuk: During the last week of the month of Habakkuk, as we focus on fasting and intercessory prayer, I encourage to intercede for the impossible. God specializes in what appears to be impossible. Trust God to do what He alone can do. Review these seemingly impossible situations and recall how God can respond to fasting and prayer if we would only trust Him to do the impossible!

Esther 4:13-17

¹³ And Mordecai told them to answer Esther: "Do not think in your heart that you will escape in the king's palace any more than all the other Jews. ¹⁴ For if you remain completely silent at this time, relief and deliverance will arise for the Jews from another place, but you and your father's house will perish. Yet who knows whether you have come to the kingdom for such a time as this?" ¹⁵ Then Esther told them to reply to Mordecai: ¹⁶ "Go, gather all the Jews who are present in ^[C] Shushan, and fast for me; neither eat nor drink for three days, night or day. My maids and I will fast likewise. And so I will go to the king, which is against the law; and if I perish, I perish!" ¹⁷ So Mordecai went his way and did according to all that Esther commanded him.

2 Chronicles 20:1-5

It happened after this that the people of Moab with the people of Ammon, and others with them besides the Ammonites,^[a] came to battle against Jehoshaphat.² Then some came and told Jehoshaphat, saying, "A great multitude is coming against you from beyond the sea, from ^[b]Syria; and they are in Hazazon Tamar" (which is En Gedi). ³ And Jehoshaphat feared, and set ^[c]himself to seek the LORD, and proclaimed a fast throughout all Judah. ⁴ So Judah gathered together to ask help from the LORD; and from all the cities of Judah they came to seek the LORD.
